

# **Batt Family Fun Center**

**Nothing is more important to us than the health and safety of our guests and staff. In addition to following State and Federal guidelines on COVID-19, we are taking precautions to ensure your visit with us will be safe. These measures include the following:**

## **HEALTH and SAFETY STANDARDS**

- The frequency of cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing has been increased in all public spaces with an emphasis on frequent contact surfaces. All staff members have received training on Covid-19 safety and cleaning procedures.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for all guests to use and will be checked and replenished hourly.
- We will regularly clean and sanitize guest touchpoints and surfaces.
- All staff will be temperature checked prior to beginning their shifts. Staff who exhibits signs of illness, such as a fever over 100.4 degrees, cough or shortness of breath will be sent home.
- All staff have been instructed to wash their hands, or use sanitizer when a sink not available, every 60 minutes (for twenty seconds) or after any guest contact or cleaning procedures.
- Restaurant staff will wear personal protective equipment (face masks) and gloves and adhere to social distancing guidelines. Face masks will be worn by other staff if requested or if proper social distancing or barriers not possible.
- Bowling balls and rental shoes will be sanitized before and after each use. We ask guests to leave bowling balls and rental shoes in the bowler's area. Our staff will clean and sanitize after you leave.
- All food items will be served in disposable to-go containers and condiments served in individual in to-go packets or cups

## **SOCIAL DISTANCING AND CAPACITY**

- Our center will comply with local or state mandated occupancy limits. Our center is in Full Phase I and will operate at 50% capacity and the count will be monitored closely to ensure the appropriate numbers of guests are in the center at any one time.
- Guests and staff must practice proper social distancing by standing at least 6 feet away from other groups. Groups are currently limited to 10 people.
- An empty lane will separate bowlers from other bowling groups.
- During league-style bowling, an empty pair of lanes will separate each pair of lanes.
- Laser tag arena and arcade have additional disinfecting and safety guidelines.
